At Babyccino, we have new bikes and cars for the children to use during outdoor play. To ensure everyone uses the equipment safety, we began to discuss and lear about wearing a helmet and using seatbelts when in a car. To ensure bike safety was not only addressed within the school, it is important that they know the road rules when riding their bikes in public areas and near roads and how to cross roads safely.

### During group time, we used a practice seatbelt to demonstrate how to put a seatbelt and ensure it is fastened correctly. Each child sat in the chair and plug their seatbelt in. This was informative as we discussed that most children are assisted by an adult when putting on a seatbelt.
